### **GRANT APPLICATIONS:**

#### Laporte

Work is complete except for walkways. Mike Hufnagle is working on an extension so that this can be completed next Spring. He is also getting the signage. Derek will contact the Borough about a painting contest to be held in the Spring. Extra concrete blocks are not needed by Davidson or Elkland and cannot be sold so they will be given to "Seeds of Hope/Neighbors Helping Neighbors" - a group overseen by Rev. Bob Brown. We need to decide if we want to ask the borough to turn on the water and if we want to purchase a water fountain. We discussed how to thank the volunteers who donated their time to this project. More discussion will take place at the next meeting after we find out the total number of volunteers but definitely MUST thank in the paper.
